**Shippers and carriers ratifies the agreement which opens the path to the resolution of their strife.**

On the past Tuesday the agreement between the associations of shippers and the National Road Transport (CNTC) has finally been ratified, with the aim of "encouraging" and "promote" solutions to the difficulties that the trade relations are going through. Except Fetransa, the agreement has been ratified by the other organizations present in the CNTC carriers and shippers and by the three associations (Aecoc, Aeutransmer and Transpime). Despite the importance of the agreement, most of the signatories have not been the presidents of the different organizations and associations, but managers and lower level responsible have assumed this responsibility. Thus, besides the President of CNTC, Ovidio de la Roza, only Elsa Coelho and July Villaescuesa of Aeutransmer, Peter Alfonsel of Fedat have taken the reins from his position of president.
