Spanish ports are consolidated among the top 20 in Europe, occupying the fifth, eighth, twelfth and eighteenth position.

The ports of Valencia, Bay of Algeciras, Barcelona and Las Palmas moved 10.2 million TEUs in 2010, with an average growth of around 7% regarding 2009. These results place the Spanish ports among the world's first one hundred and twenty largest in Europe. Valencia was ranked 26th in the world and 5th of Europe; Bay of Algeciras on 42th and 8th; Barcelona 63th and 12th and Las Palmas 95th and 18th, respectively, in the ranking of the top one hundred world ports in this type of traffic that has published the English magazine Cargo System.
